

Must be REGISTERED ADULT to camp with the Troop

All registered adult leaders must complete YPT training ANNUALLY

We encourage everyone to take the training

St. Joseph Church Rules

Virtus Training for every registered adult leader and drivers

We CANNOT register any adult until the Church approves

Critical Issue - Cannot re-register you without training!

At least one parent/guardian from each family must be Virtus Trained and DMV Background Approved. No Cost for Registration


